- Test x-rays for PPD, need annual questionnaire

• Item 5: Immunocompromised and unable to receive immunizations

- $\circ \quad Follow-up\ immunizations/titers\ non-reactive?$
- Waivers to sign?
- Placement assignment and communication? Where is the liability? Disclosure?
- o Student needs to give permission for disclosure.
- Clinical affiliation wording is very strict.
- mCE would indicate the student was not immunized, the facility should contact the school to get more information and process on a case by case basis.
- Flu vaccine date may change annually but will likely be October 1st.-March 31st. Expiration date will be entered into mCE (not the date the student received the shot). It is good for 1 year.
