

SBAR REPORT TO A PHYSICIAN

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Have@ hand: Charts, Labs/Results

SITUATION: Who & where you are, who you are calling about and *briefly* why you are calling

BACKGROUND: Admission date, age & Dx., pertinent medical history, a brief synopsis of the treatment to date, and why is patient on the unit?

ASSESSMENT: What do *YOU* think is going on? *SAY IT!* What is happening that *CONCERNS* you?

RECOMMENDATION: What would you like the Physician *TO DO?* Why did you call, what do you want? (It is O.K. to say "I'm not sure what the patient needs, I need your help troubleshooting this situation".

✚ You are encouraged to brainstorm patient issues with the SSC/experienced peer prior to placing a call to a physician regarding a patient complaint.

✚ Before you hang up, please make sure you are on the same page as the physician regarding the immediate plan of care.

✚ DOCUMENT THE CHANGE IN PATIENT CONDITION & PHYSICIAN NOTIFICATION 

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
