Register as an Employer

STEP 1:

Complete necessary documents to enroll as an employer and get registered with Department of Labor.



Identify Site Coordinator, Preceptor(s) & Mentor(s)

STEP 2:

Identify the Site Coordinator for your organization, who will lead efforts to support your new graduate nurse residents. Identify Preceptors and Mentors, and enroll them in Preceptor & Mentor trainings.



Recruit, Hire & Enroll New Graduate RN

STEP 3

Recruit and hire new graduate nurses. Set them up for your organization orientation. Enroll them in the online portion of the WINN New Graduate Nurse Rural Residency program.

Begin 12-Month Residency & Attend Monthly Meetings

STEP 4:

New graduate nurse resident will begin 12-month residency and attend required monthly meetings. Site Coordinator will meet monthly with nurse resident, Preceptor, Mentor and WINN Team.

STEP 5:

Nurse Resident will transition into practice with completion of 12-month residency and support of your organization and the WINN Team and continue in the progression of their professional growth and development as a nurse!
